STEP 1 : Hardware Installation

Installing the Hard Disk Drive

1. Push the silver button to release the HDD tray.



2. Pull out the HDD tray.




3. Place the HDD on the tray and secure the HDD with the screws at the bottom (as illustrated).



4. Push the tray back in the unit and press down the black bar to secure the tray.



STEP 2 : Hardware Connection



| Steps | Description |
|-------|--|
| 1 | Connect NAS-7202 and a Switch, Hub, Router, or computer with RJ-45 Ethernet cable. |
| 2 | [Optional] Connect USB storage device(s) to this device with USB cable(s). NAS-7202 can automatically mount the USB devices connected. |
| 3 | Connect the power supply to NAS-7202. |
| 4 | Press the "Power button" to turn on NAS-7202. The HDD activate LED on the front panel will light up during booting-up. NAS-7202 will be ready to use when the blue LED lights up steady. |


STEP 3 : Web Management

Install "NAS Finder for Windows" utility from the CD
 Please go to Start → Programs → PLANET → NAS-7202 → NAS Finder → Refresh to run the search tool.
 The NAS-7202 should be located and its IP address should be displayed:
 Double-click on it and the program should automatically access the NAS-7202's web administration page from your default browser.



Login the Homepage

The Web management allows you to access and manage the NAS RAID Server easily. Launch the Web browser and then enter the IP address. The default IP address is 192.168.0.100 and fill the User Name and Password to login the Web management. The default User Name / Password is **admin / admin**.
